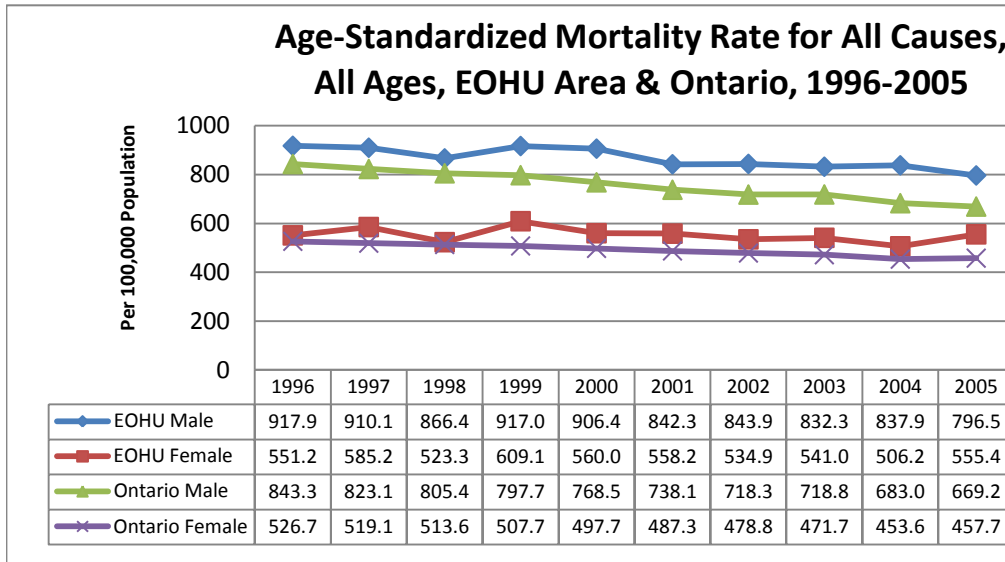

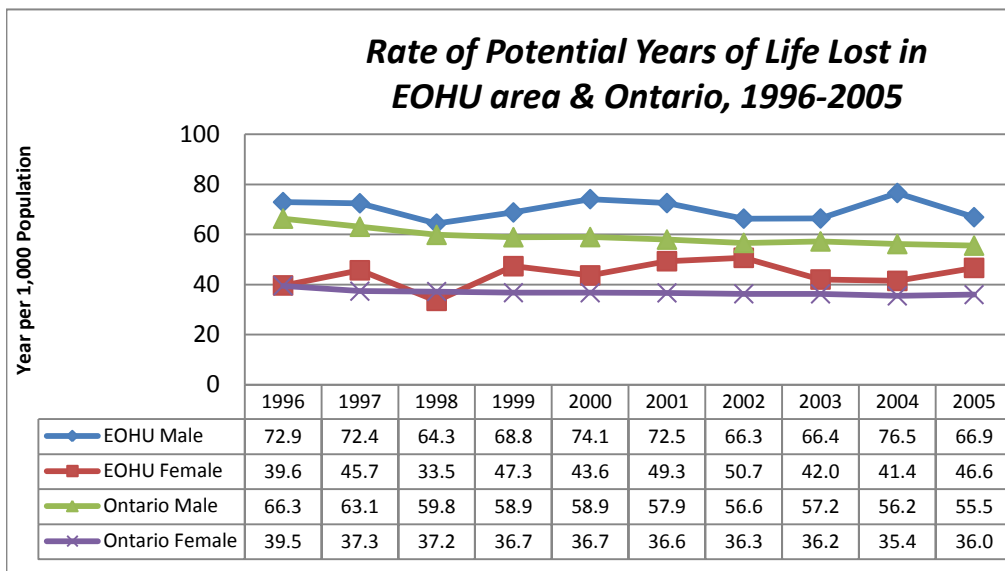

### 3-02. Potential Years of Life Lost (Before Age 75)

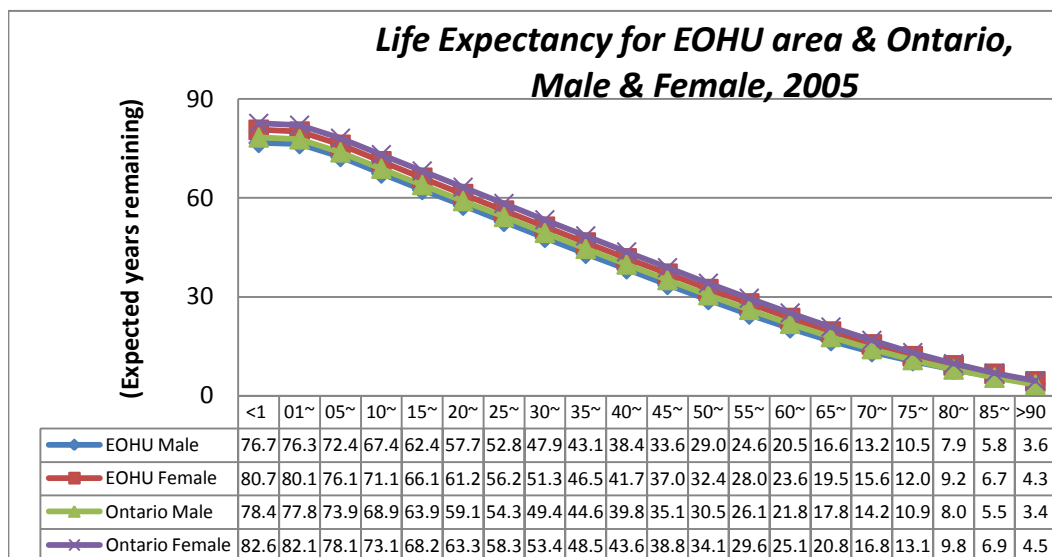

### 3-03. Life Expectancy

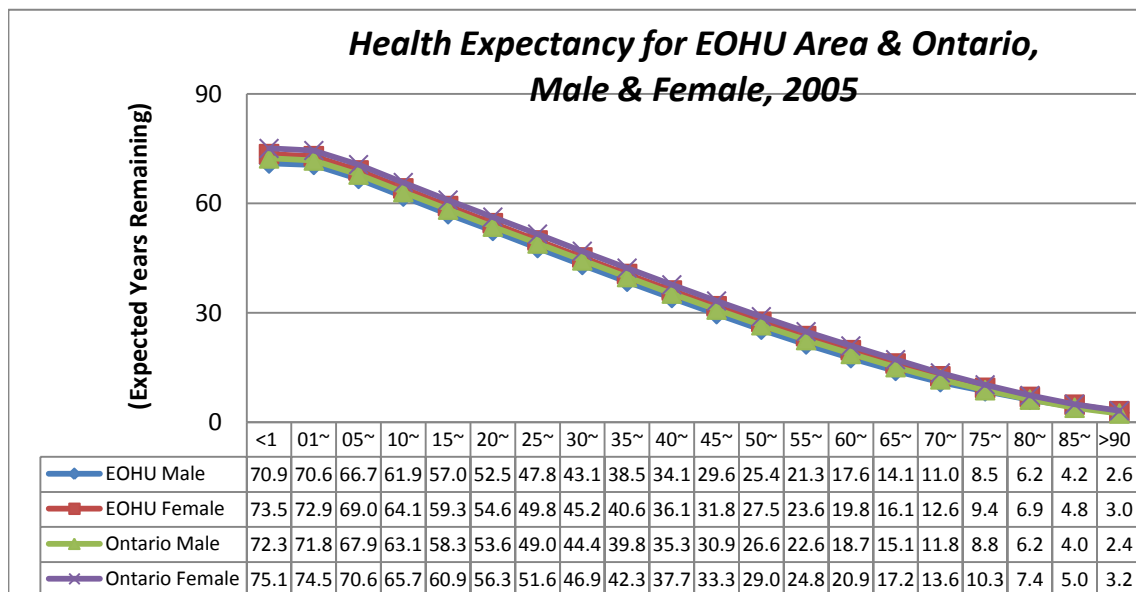

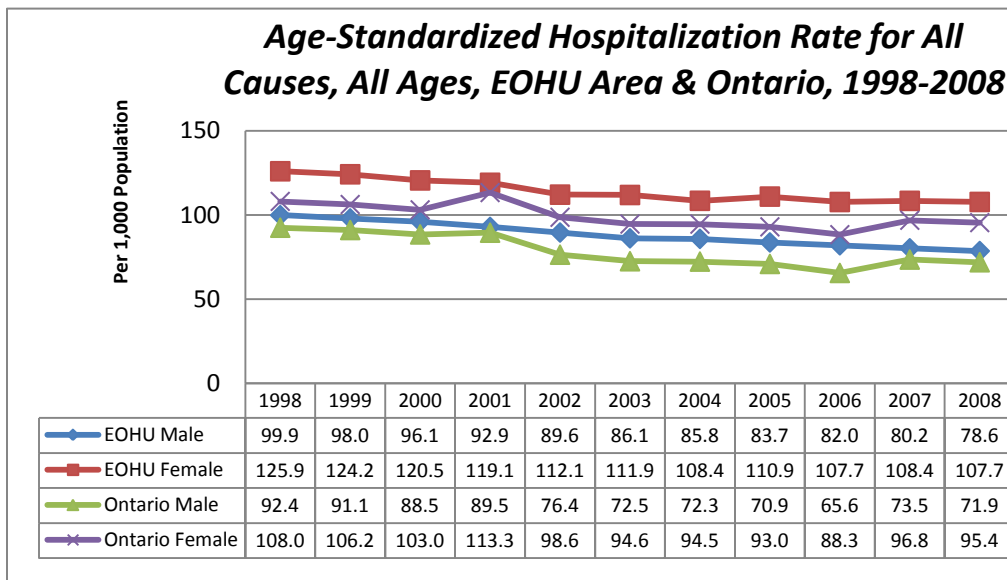

### 3-05. All-Cause Hospitalization

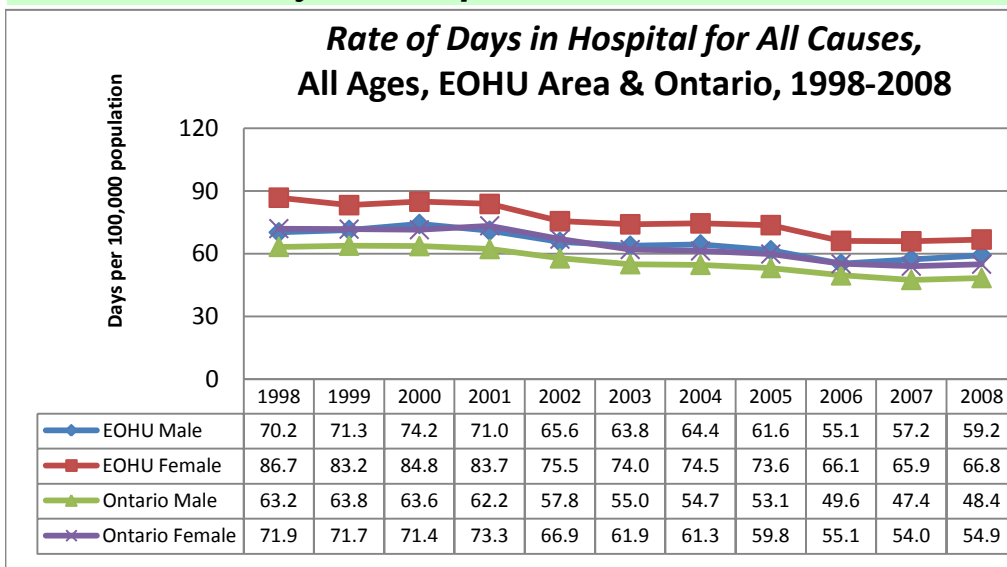

### 3-06. Rate of Days in Hospital

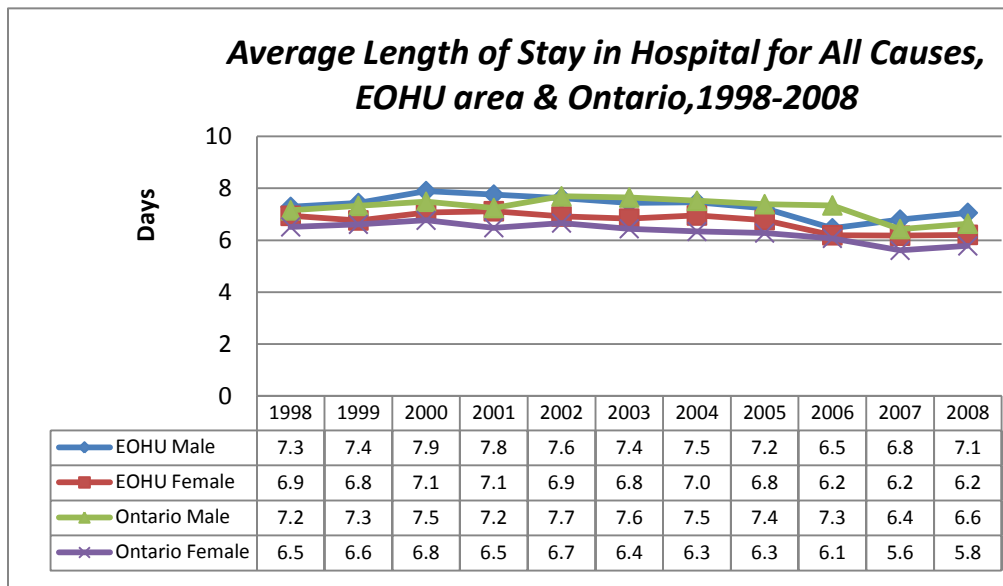

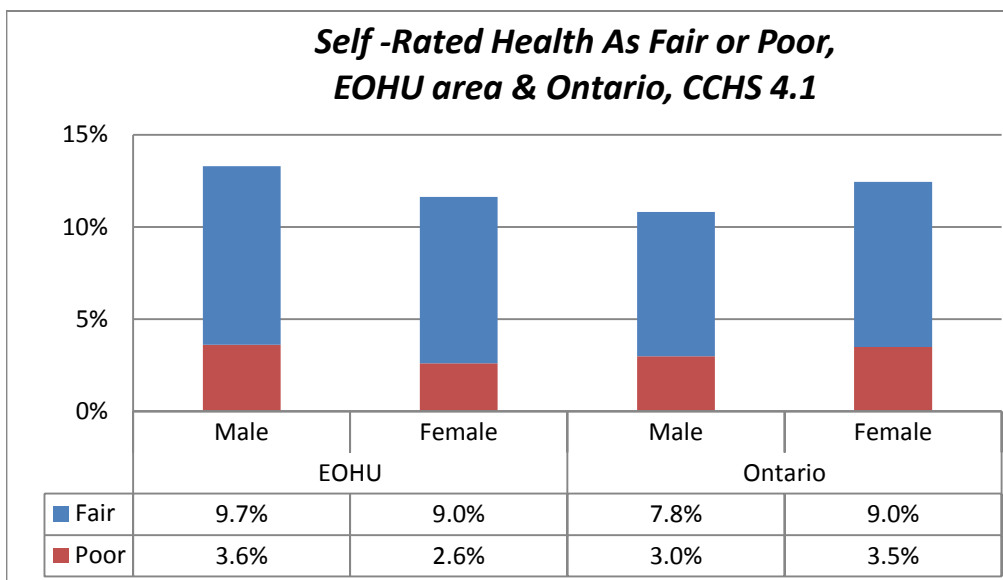

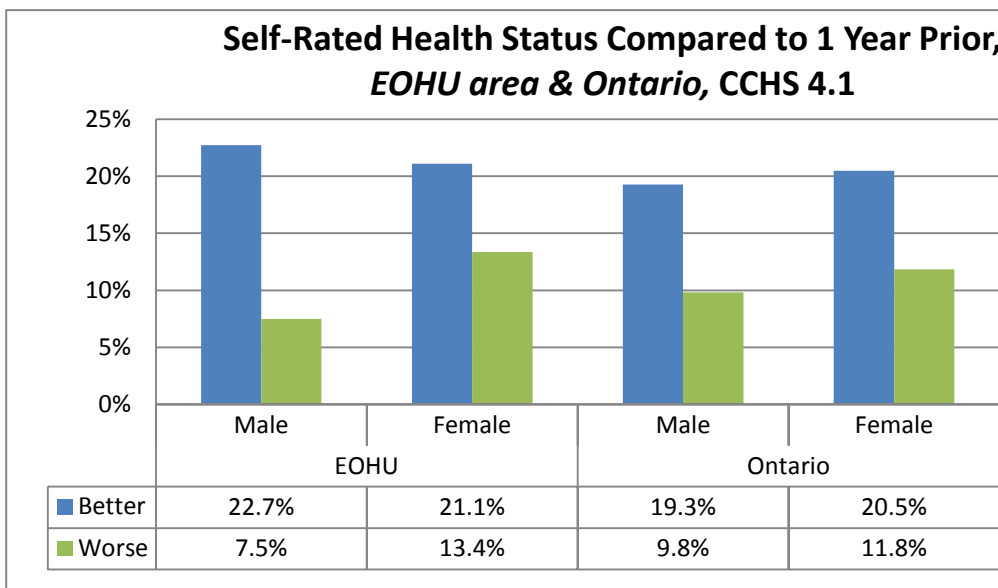

#### Self -Rated Health As Fair or Poor



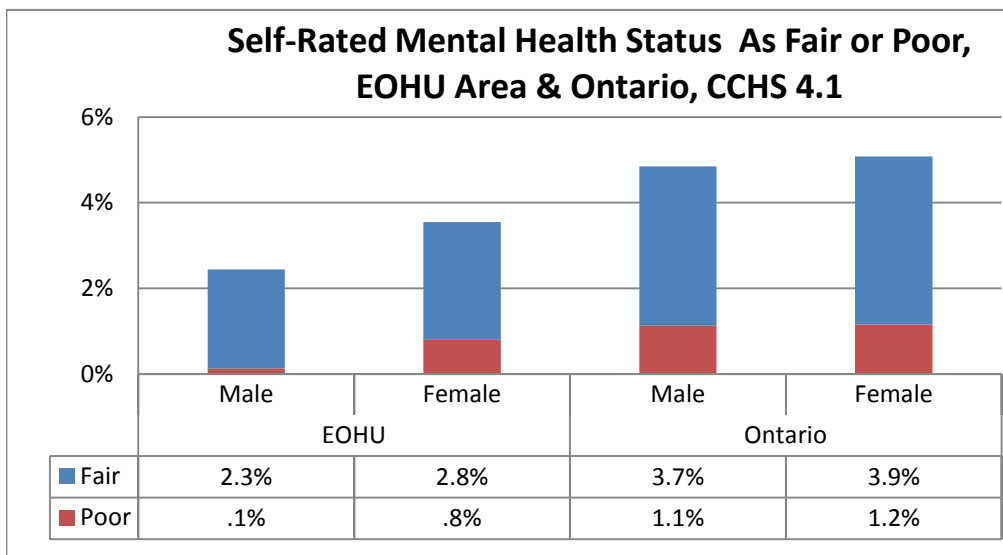
