

RABIES CONTROL PROGRAM – ANIMAL TO HUMAN EXPOSURE REPORTING FORM

The Eastern Ontario Health Unit (EOHU) must be informed of all animal exposures.

PLEASE NOTE:

- rPEP administration must be authorized by the EOHU. Pre-positioning could stop if rPEP is administered without an EOHU consult and/or there are concerns about the accuracy of inventory tracking.
- Fax is adequate when rPEP is not warranted/offered (domestic animals that can be confined, small rodents, etc.); the reporting form should be completed with as much detail as possible. Fax completed form to 613-933-7417.
